Re: Easement of Restrictions

Dear Tenants, Families & Visitors;

On Monday, July 4, 2022 the province announced easement of restrictions around Covid-19.

First, I must impress the Pandemic is not over, we still need to be cautious.

Beginning today, July 6, 2022:

- Family and/or visitors do not require to show proof of vaccination.
- Staff, volunteers and contracted services still require to show vaccination status.
- Masking is still mandatory in all public areas of our facilities. Family and visitors can remove masks once inside the apartment.
- Passive self screening must take place before you enter our Assisted Living, for example:
Do you have.
 - Cough
 - Fever
 - Congestion
 - Headache
 - Or any symptoms of influenza like illness, please do not visit until symptoms resolve.
- Please continue to sanitize your hands before entering and leaving facility.
